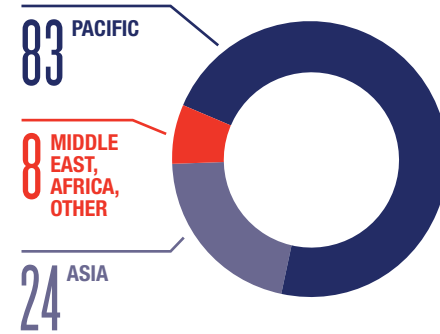

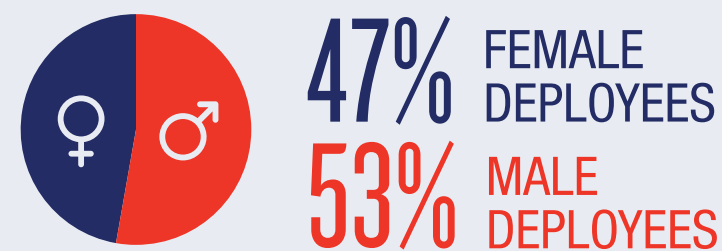

- PREPARE AND DISSEMINATE NATIONAL GUIDELINES ON COVID-19 INFECTION PREVENTION AND CONTROL IN **PAPUA NEW GUINEA**.
- DEVELOP A NATIONAL COVID-19 RESPONSE PLAN AND DELIVER RELATED SIMULATION TRAINING IN **KIRIBATI**.
- EMBED GENDER EQUALITY AWARENESS INTO COVID-19 PROGRAMS TO PREVENT GENDER-BASED VIOLENCE (GBV) DURING A TIME OF ESCALATING GBV RISKS IN **JORDAN**.
