


# **Climate Change**

Working with FAO and the Government, these consecutive deployments resulted in the development of a DRM strategy and plan for agriculture to help strengthen the resilience of agriculture-dependent communities to better cope with climate-related hazards.

Working with WHO and the Department of Health, Shannon supported the development of campaign materials to combat vaccine hesitancy and prevent the spread of COVID-19.
