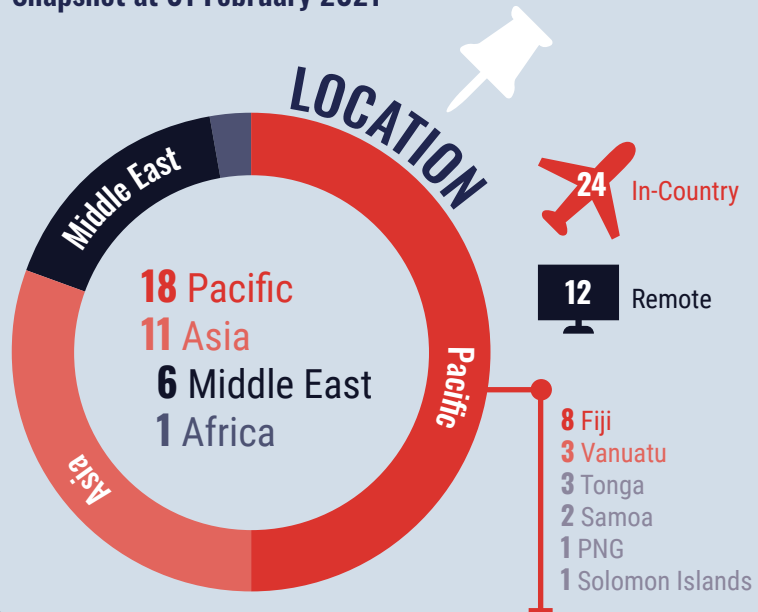


Australia Assists Deployments

Snapshot at 01 February 2021

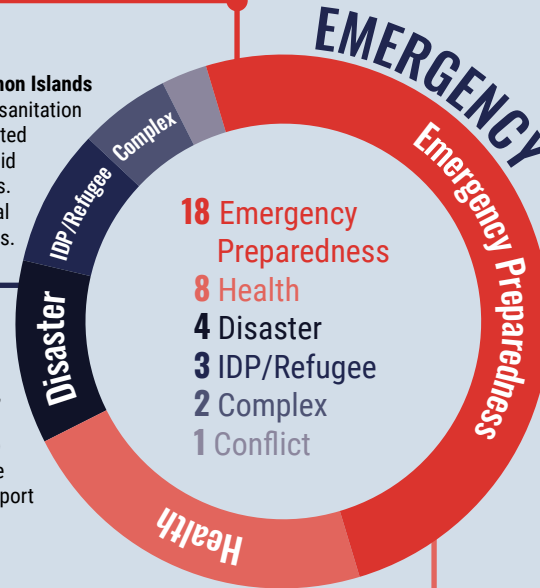


WASH

WASH specialist, **Tai**, is working with UNICEF in **Solomon Islands** on the implementation and expansion of hygiene and sanitation initiatives across nearly 300 communities. Tai conducted field visits to existing project sites and designed a rapid household survey to evaluate impact and identify gaps. Tai also engaged with key stakeholders, including local officials and NGOs, to consult on planned interventions.

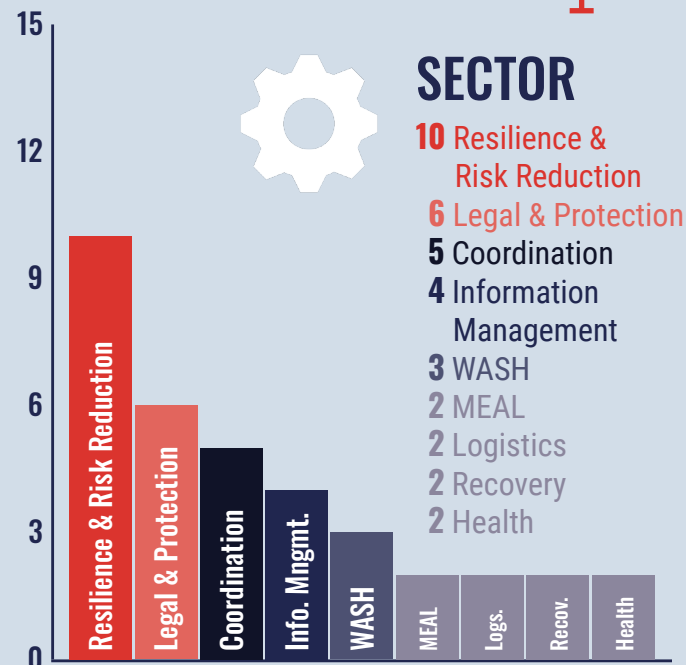
Cyclone Response

Humanitarian Affairs Officer, **Tim**, is supporting OCHA's humanitarian response efforts in the Pacific, including COVID-19. In September, Tim worked with local specialists and RedR Australia regional staff to deliver humanitarian training in **Fiji**, ahead of cyclone season. Tim's deployment has been extended to support recent cyclone response and recovery efforts.



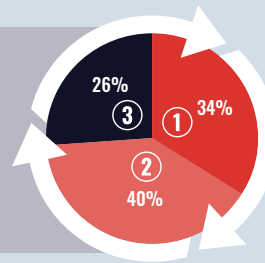
Preparedness

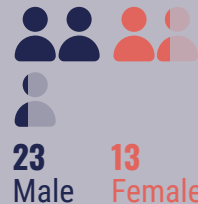
Across the Disaster Cycle
